TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- All permit holders must have a Valid Carp Society Membership for the length of their permit; any lapse memberships will invalidate the permit.
 - The PIKE PERMIT is specifically for PIKE FISHING only, no fishing for other species is permitted on this permit
 - Access from Dawn to Dusk only, No overnight fishing/stay is permitted
 - ALL LAKE RULES APPLY TO PERMIT HOLDERS – enclosed with your permit
The Carp Society reserves the right to add/amend rules at any time during the permit time; changes will be posted on the website.
 - Photos of captures must be emailed to info@thecarpsociety.com
 - Non-fishing guests (partners and/or children ONLY) must hold a valid membership to accompany the permit holder (access for guests is subject to change at the discretion of the Carp Society)
 - Permits will be issued on receipt of full payment, form and photos
 - All permits are NON TRANSFERABLE and NON REFUNDABLE (see terms and conditions)
 - *Your details provided may be used to send promotional material relating to your permit, membership and news regarding the Carp Society; you may Opt out at any time.*

KEY

Permit holders will be provided with an access card for entry to Horseshoe Lake.

All cards are individually programmed to the permit type and will expire when your permit runs out. Access may be temporarily blocked in the event of lake closures to manage access to the lake and reinstated when the lake is open to anglers.

Lost cards: In the event of cards being lost it is imperative that the office is notified immediately, replacement cards will be charged at £30 per card.

LAKE OR SWIM CLOSURES:

For the duration of your permit the lake or swims may be closed to facilitate Carp Society/fishing/filming events. A list of LAKE closure events will available online/in the carp society office and may be updated throughout the period of your permit. Unplanned lake closures will be notified on the website and Facebook page.

Fish Spawning:

The lake or swims may be closed without prior notice by the Fishery Manager or Bailiff team when spawning occurs or otherwise.

The Directors reserve the right to close the lake without prior notice at their discretion for any reason, with no liability of compensation, refunds or extensions offered.

The permit is non-transferable and non-refundable.

No refunds/discounts will be offered for any lake closures natural or otherwise, including government instructed closures or travel restrictions.

Once purchased permits are non-refundable, any anglers choosing to surrender their ticket will not be offered a refund or credit for any reason.

Rule infringements: The Carp Society reserves the right to remove angler's permits and access if believed to be/caught breaching the lake rules with no liability of compensation, refunds or credit. If you have a query about any of the rules or seek clarification please contact the Carp Society office, Head Bailiff or Fishery Manager. The Carp Society reserve the right to reject an application for any reason.
